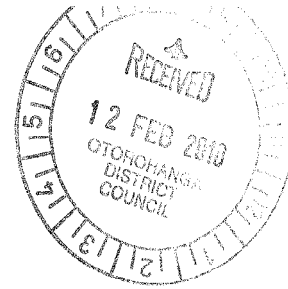
Report Discussion

Dear Mrs. Cowan

I am the special needs teacher of the senior class special needs unit at Otorohanga South School. I have a class of five students from 16 to 19 years old and four of these students use both the gym and pool at The Leisure Club on a regular basis. In fact the only day we are not up there is on a Wednesday. Overall we find the facilities excellent except for changing facilities for one of our swimming students.

This student is 16 years old and is therefore an adult size; he is in a wheelchair and cannot move on his own. Swimming for him is an excellent therapy and gives him a great deal of pleasure but the changing is both difficult and hazardous. The staff accompanying him needs to lay him flat on the floor, they then need to maneuver themselves around him to dry and dress him and then lift him from the floor and into his wheelchair. This does place a great deal of physical strain on them and is extremely unpleasant for the student. Therefore we were wondering if it would be possible to have an adult changing table installed in one of the changing rooms. Using a changing table would be more respectful for our student, and as he does assist with standing transfers from a table to his chair it would lessen the physical stress on staff.

You have a hoist chair for entry to the pool so already partially cater for individuals with disabilities; it would be great to see a further piece of equipment installed.

On behalf of the users of the Otorohanga Swimming Pool, I would like to apply for funding to subsidize the building of a diving facility at the swimming pool complex, and the possible development of the waste ground at the end of the outside swimming pool. As both a parent and a staff member I would highly recommend this as it would help occupy the vast number of children we supervise during holidays, weekends and after school during the summer months.

The waste ground would be ideal for a picnic and barbeque area with a shade cloth and a basketball hoop. We already have a hoop and backboard available but would like some money to help with a pole and concrete.
