Item-39 REPLACEMENT STREET LITTER BINS

Executive Summary

The litter bins in both Otorohanga and Kawhia Communities are showing signs of age, wear and tear. With the installation of the Recycling Bins in the Otorohanga CBD, the old style green bins appear insignificant by comparison. The Kawhia Community Board have indicated they wish to replace the green bins with a different style of bin.

Does the Otorohanga Community Board want to replace the current green bins with something better and similar to match the Recycling Bins or continue to use the existing green bin style?

Staff Recommendation

It is recommended that

1. The Report be received.
2. New bins be purchased as budget restraints allow, with the Esplanade style bin to match the current recycling bins, with the appropriate logos that each Community has chosen.

Report Discussion

From discussions with the Contractor it is suggested that we install a similar style bin to the Recycling bin that holds a 120L wheelie bin. This allows their staff easy access under and around the bin for cleaning up purposes. The current green bins are difficult to clean at the bottom and an accumulation of debris has occurred, attracting ants and rodents. The 120L wheelie bin will be lined with a plastic rubbish bag for easy pickup by staff and will not require a vehicle with a bin lifter.

Under the terms of the current contract, the Contractor is responsible for repairs of the bins:

3.1.5 The Contractor shall be responsible for cleaning, maintenance and replacement (if required) of litter bins as determined by their condition.

Bins shall be of a conventional standard for urban areas, and if new types of bins are to be introduced these will require the approval of the Engineer.

3.1.6 The Contractor shall be responsible for repair and replacement (including complete re-installation if necessary) of any litter bins should they be damaged by vandalism, fire or any other reason.

In this context the term “replacement” means that if a bin is requiring maintenance it is to be removed from the site and replaced with a stock item. It does not mean to purchase new bins.

Quotes have been received from AE Tilley and Street Furniture NZ for the supply of new bins.

Street Furniture NZ supply the current green bins at a cost of \$587.00.

A small amount is allocated in the street litter bin budget annually to allow for old green bins to be renewed and in the current year, up to 5 could be purchased. At the Kawhia Community Board meeting they requested funding be included in the estimates for 2011/12 and 2012/13 for replacement of their green litter bins with a more attractive bin to replace their main street bins. This has been included.

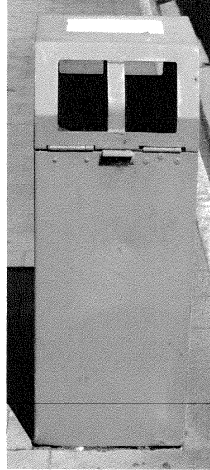
Does the Otorohanga Community Board wish to follow this approach of replacing the main street litter bins with a more modern style or continue to use the existing green bin style? Existing bins would be repaired and repainted as required with new bins purchased to replace existing bins that are beyond repair. Some of the surplus green bins from Kawhia could be refurbished and reused in Otorohanga if the green bin style is to be retained. Funding already in the budget could be utilised to replace 3 or 4 litter bins with a more attractive bin this financial year and a similar amount next year. Exact amounts will depend on installation costs.

AE Tilley offer a free delivery service. Installation costs are estimated at \$500 per bin as a concrete pad needs to be installed for each one. Further quotes are being sought to reduce this cost. EnviroWaste will supply the 120L wheelie bin at no cost to Council. Decals will be a minimal cost.

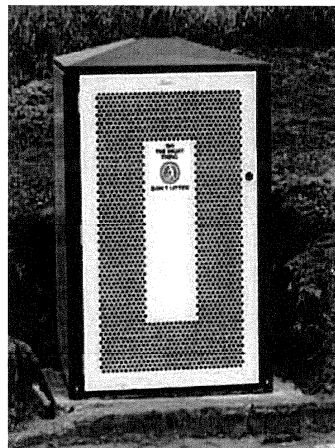
Current street litter bins
