NOTES

1. If the election is in respect of a subdivision of a local government area (i.e. ward, constituency or community board), including a constituency of a DHB, the nominators must be electors of that subdivision, and, if by any enactment a candidate is not qualified for election unless he/she is an elector of the subdivision, the nominee must also be an elector of that subdivision.
2. A nominator in the case of a candidate for City, District and Regional Council or a community board may be a residential or ratepayer elector.
3. A candidate **cannot** nominate themselves for office.
4. Where no affiliation is claimed, or an affiliation is disallowed by the electoral officer under Section 57 of the Act, nothing will be shown in the said public notice against the candidate's name, whether or not any other candidates have claimed an affiliation.
5. Under Section 121 of the Local Electoral Act 2001, any person is liable to a fine of \$2,000 who:
 - a. Knowing themselves to be ineligible for election, (for further information about candidates qualifications please see Attachment A to this nomination paper); or
 - b. Nominates any person as a candidate whom he/she knows to be ineligible for election; or
 - c. Not being the candidate signs any nomination paper knowing that they are not qualified to vote at the election.
6. A candidate may under Section 56 of the Local Electoral Act be nominated under a name which the candidate is commonly known provided that the name will not:
 - cause offence to a reasonable person
 - be unreasonably long
 - include or resemble an official rank or title
 - cause confusion or mislead electors
7. A candidate may, in accordance with Section 61 of the Local Electoral Act 2001 and Clauses 26 to 29 of the Local Electoral Regulations 2001, provide a candidate profile statement including a recent photograph for dispatch to electors with the voting documents. For further information about candidate profile statements please see attachment B to this nomination paper.
8. Nominations of candidates must be in the hands of the **Electoral Officer, Otorohanga District Council, Otorohanga, not later than 20 August 2010, 12noon.**
9. Each nomination must be accompanied by the required deposit of **\$200.00** (inclusive of GST).
10. Evidence of NZ citizenship may be requested at time of candidate nomination. Acceptable evidence includes NZ Passport, NZ Birth Certificate, NZ Citizenship documentation.
