1. This is an application by Navdeep Singh Khangura for the renewal of a Manager's Certificate.

- 2. On 15 March 2025, Kiwitown Liquor Centre failed a Controlled Purchase Operation (CPO) when alcohol was sold to a minor. The sale was made by Mr Khangura, who was the duty manager at the time. Following the failed CPO, the Licensing Inspector reports that Mr Khangura has received additional training from the licensee on 26 March 2025 and attended the Club Champs training session in Te Awamutu, 24 March 2025.
- 3. Police have not opposed the application. The Inspector has confirmed she would support the renewal of the Manager's Certificate on the basis that it be truncated to a period of 12 months to allow continued monitoring.
- 4. In order to consider this, the Committee would like to meet with Mr Khangura to better understand the matters surrounding the failed CPO, and to assess his understanding of the Act. Therefore, I direct that the application be set down to be heard at a public hearing by the District Licensing Committee.<sup>1</sup>
- 5. Mr Khangura is employed by JD 2023 Limited, which has applied to renew its off-licence. A hearing for that application is scheduled for 25 July 2025. To ensure efficiency, it is recommended that the hearing for Mr Khangura's Manager's Certificate be held on the same day, following the off-licence hearing. If time does not permit, an alternative date will be proposed.
- 6. The timeframes for filing evidence are as follows:
  - All briefs of evidence and any other documentary material that the reporting agencies seek to introduce into evidence must be filed within 20 working days of the hearing.
  - All briefs of evidence and any other documentary material that the Mr Khangura seeks to introduce into evidence must be filed within 10 working days of the hearing.

#### Introduction

- 1. Nam Pham is my full name. I am employed by Otorohanga District Council as a licensing Inspector. I am here assisting the DLC.
- 2. My work includes enquiring and reporting on alcohol licence applications under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 throughout Otorohanga District. I have 3 years' experience.
- 3. Before the committee today is an application for a renewal application for the manager's certificate from Navdeep Singh Khangura.
- 4. Applicant works part time for JD 2023 Limited.
- 5. Applicant was the duty manager who had a failed CPO on 15 March 2025
- 6. Applicant has an ARLA decision for a suspension of applicant's managers certificate, decision [2025] NZARLA 170 attached.
- 7. On 15 March 2025, the same date with the failed CPO incident, the inspector observed the duty manager who works for the above licensee had sold a bottle of white wine alcohol to a lady. Bottle was priced \$11, sold for \$5, confirmed the rest \$6 will be paid on a later date. During the conversation the lady leaned against the counter multiple times and although the duty manager initial refused the sale, this lady insisted that the duty manager must phone his boss to confirm the deal and must sell the wine bottle to her. The applicant finally sold the bottle of wine to the lady.
- 8. Applicant has the appropriate qualifications as prescribed by the Act
- 9. Applicant was interviewed on 7 May 2025. I use a series of questions to assess applicant understanding about the Objects of the Act, the tools and how to define if a person is intoxicated, host responsibility, etc. Applicant can answer most of the questions right.
- 10. Applicant provided evidence of training following the failed CPO, including internal training with licensee and external training by attending Clubchamps.
- 11. I have discussed a truncated renewal period of would be appropriate because applicant will have a shorter time before another assessment during renewal application. Applicant has agreed to truncated renewal condition.

#### **DECISION OF THE AUTHORITY**

- [1] By application dated 30 May 2025, Licensing Inspector Mary Fernandez of Waipa District Council seeks suspension of a manager's certificate following a controlled purchase operation conducted on 15 March 2025 during which alcohol was sold to a person under the purchase age in breach of s 239 of the Act. The application is made pursuant to s 285(3)(a) of the Act.
- [2] The respondent does not dispute the ground of the application and he has agreed to suspension of his manager's certificate. Accordingly, we make the following order by consent:

manager's certificate number 20/CERT/3223/2024, issued to Navdeep Singh Khangura, is suspended for 28 days from Monday 21<sup>st</sup> July 2025 until Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> August 2025 (both dates inclusive).

[3] This order is deemed to be a negative holding in terms of ss 288(1) and 290 of the Act. If the certificate has not already been cancelled, three negative holdings incurred within a three-year period will result in an order cancelling the certificate.

#### 1 SUMMARY OF APPLICATION

Application for the renewal of Managers Certificate was received by the Otorohanga District Licensing Committee on 23 April 2025 pursuant to section 224 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

The application was in the correct form as detailed by section 224 of the Act and was accompanied by the correct fee.

#### 2 SUITABILITY OF THE APPLICANT

The applicant is over the age of 20 and holds a student visa valid until 31 March 2026 which allows applicant to work up to 20 hours per week during school term and 40 hours a week during summer vacation, including term-breaks. The applicant held the manager's certificate for one year and was issued by Taupo City Council hence this is the first renewal of the managers certificate.

Applicant confirms he has no convictions.

Applicant holds the prescribed qualification detailed in section 218.

#### 3 ANY CONVICTIONS RECORDED AGAINST THE APPLICANT

The police have confirmed this applicant has no convictions.

#### 4 MANNER IN WHICH APPLICANT HAS MANAGED LICENSED PREMISES

The applicant has a failed CPO on 15 March 2025. The applicant has given statement and agreed to have his certificate suspended pursuant to section 285 of the Act. An application for a suspension of the managers certificate has been applied to ARLA on 15 April 2025 and is in processing.

The associated licence premises has a notice of hearing in place scheduled for 25 July 2025 hearing. This process is a part of the off-licence renewal process, in which the licensing inspector opposed the renewal process after observing Navdeep sold a bottle of alcohol at half price under the listed price to a person who could be under influenced. The matter will be heard at the hearing.

#### 5 TRAINING AND PRESCRIBED QUALIFICATION

Applicant holds the licence controller qualification issued under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and is dated 9 February 2024. A copy was provided through email and is attached.

Applicant has attended Servewise Host Responsibility training in January 2025. After the failed CPO applicant has been trained by licensee on 26 March 2025 and has attended the recent Clubchamps training held at Te Awamutu on 24 March 2025. Copies of training records attached to this report.

I am satisfied that the applicant has the appropriate qualifications and training.

#### **6** POLICE REPORT

Police have sent an email dated 28 April 2025 confirm no objection to the application.

#### 7 LICENSING INSPECTOR'S COMMENT

The applicant was interviewed on 7 May 2025. We discussed about the failed CPO incident and what lesson the applicant has for himself in the future. Navdeep confirmed that he is now checking ID for anyone looks under the age of 25 and adhere to licence host responsibility.

Navdeep shared that he has been juggling between studying and working to support his studying. He only works part-time for licensee and wishes to have his certificate renewed and keep working. Navdeep understands that he must have a valid visa to use the manager's certificate.

The inspector's view is that Navdeep's certificate could be renewed with a truncated period of 12 months, which were discussed during the interview and Navdeep agreed to that condition. Navdeep has sent an email dated 8 May 2025 confirming that, and a copy attached to this report.

#### 8 CONCLUSION

There is no opposition to the re-issue of manager's certificate to Navdeep Singh Khangura however I recommend certificate should be renewed with a 12-month truncated period.


