

ITEM 3: ŌTOROHANGA COMMUNITY GRANTS FUND – CONSIDERATION OF APPLICATIONS FOR ROUND ONE OF 2022/23

Council's Group Manager Strategy and Community, N Gower advised 21 applications were received requesting most of the funding available. She noted the application form had been revised to enable assessment across the applications to be easier. She also reiterated the need to 'fund for success' which may mean the Committee included conditions with the grant. Ms Gower advised her advice to the Christmas Parade Project Kiwiana Committee - Ōtorohanga District Development Board Inc was to apply for funding in round two of each year as round one was too close to the holiday period to provide the necessary certainty of funding should they be successful in their application.

Members discussed the applications received individually then reviewed the funding requested as a whole. In response to a query, Ms Gower advised staff could prepare a webpage with links to other funding available and add reference in the grant/decline letter to each applicant.
