DECISION OF THE DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

1. The application for a manager's certificate is granted. The manager's certificate may issue immediately.
2. The manager's certificate shall continue in force until the close of the period of the day 12 months after the day it is issued.

REASONS

1. Thomas Moke intends to be the day-to-day manager at the new Kawhia hotel, Sands of Kawhia. He is in the process of applying for an On-Licence for these premises and has applied for a manager's certificate.
2. The Liquor Licensing Inspector and Police have provided reports and do not object to the application (s 220). Accordingly, this application is decided on the papers (s 202).
3. In considering an application for a manager's certificate the licensing committee must consider the following questions (s 222):
 - a) Is the applicant suitable to be a manager?
 - b) Have any convictions been recorded against the applicant?
 - c) Does the applicant have any recent experience in controlling any premises for which a licence was in force?
 - d) Has the applicant undertaken appropriate training and completed relevant qualifications under section 218?
 - d) Have the Inspector and Police raised any relevant matters in their reports?

Should the manager's certificate be granted?

4. The licensing committee is satisfied that Thomas Moke is a suitable person to hold a manager's certificate because he has appropriate training, qualifications and experience and is of good character. Therefore, the manager's certificate is granted.
